

1, 2, 3

2 Players - Ranking and Ordering - Ages 10+

Goal: To correctly order three cards according to a selected category.

- Cards are shuffled and placed words down in a pile between the players.
- One player selects three cards. After examining the cards, the player gives a numerical category, then reads the state name of each card.
- The opponent tries to put the states in order from BIGGEST to SMALLEST.
- If the opponent gets all three cards in correct order, he/she earns the 3 cards.
- If only 1 state is in the correct place, that 1 card is earned.
- Roles are reversed and play continues.
- The game ends when:
 - ✓ One player wins a set number cards (10, 15 etc.).
 - ✓ Time runs out.
 - ✓ A set number of cards have been used.
- The player with the most cards wins!
