

3+ Players - Knowledge of the major cities - Ages 10+

Goal: Guess the state that the city is in.

Needed: Paper for keeping score

- Cards are shuffled and placed in a central location.
- One player goes first by selecting a card and reading one of the cities listed on the card.
- From here, there are 3 ways to play Speed Play, Turn Play, and All Play

Speed Play:

- Any player may blurt out the state the city is in.
- Players may give only **one** response.
- The player with the fastest correct response wins the card.
- If no player gives a correct answer, a second city is given. Again, players may only blurt
 one guess. All the cities may be used, usually ending with the state capital.

Turn Play:

- The reader of the city chooses a player to guess.
- If the chosen player correctly responds, he/she receives the card.
- If incorrect, a new city is read and the next player has a chance to guess.
- If guessed correctly the card is won.
- Play continues in this manner until a player correctly guesses the state.
- The last city read is the capital city.
- When the card or state has been guessed, another player is chosen to be the reader.

All Play:

- After the reader has read the city, ALL players write down a guess.
- Any player who correctly guesses the state on the first city clue earns a card and a new reader and card is chosen.
- If no player guesses correctly, the reader selects another city. Play continues in this manner until the last city is given which is always the capital city.
- A new card and a new reader are selected whenever 1 or more players correctly guess the state.
- The game ends when:
 - ✓ One player wins a set number of cards (10, 15 etc.).
 - ✓ Time runs out.
 - ✓ A set number of cards have been used.
- The player with the most cards wins!
