

Number Clue

2 or more players - Reasoning - Ages 10+

Goal: Win the most cards by guessing the category, from the given number.

- Cards are shuffled and placed words-down in a pile between the players.
- One player is chosen to go first and draws a card from the pile.
- The State Name is read to the opponent.
- This first player then selects one number from any one of the number categories and reads it to the opponent.
- The opponent has 1 chance to guess what category the number is from. If correct, the player WINS the card. *(Another card can be used to help the guessing player remember the categories.)*
- If the guess is incorrect, the card is placed words-up in a discard pile.
- The opponent now draws a card and selects a number to read.
- Play continues in this manner.
- The game ends when:
 - ✓ One player wins a set number of cards (10, 15 etc.).
 - ✓ Time runs out.
 - ✓ A set number of cards have been used.
- The player with the most cards WINS!
