

ORDER

2-4 Players - Sequencing, Sorting - Ages 7+

Goal: Get all of your cards in order (small to large) according to the value of a selected category.

- Players decide which of the following categories to use:
 1. *State Number*
 2. *Union Entry Date*
 3. *Area*
 4. *Population*
 5. *High Point*
 6. *Counties*
- Cards are shuffled.
- 7 to 10 cards are dealt words-up, in a row and **MUST** remain in the order received.
- The remaining cards are kept in a pile, words-down. The top card is placed words up next to this pile.
- The first player selects either the words-up card or the card on top of the pile and uses it to **REPLACE** an existing card in his/her line of cards.
- The selected card **MUST** be used.
- The replaced card is put on the words-up pile.
- Players take turns in this manner until one player has all of his/her cards in numerical order, in the chosen category, from small to large (left to right OR right to left). This player WINS the game.

Suggestions: Try to sort the cards in alphabetical order according to the name of the State or Capital!

NOTE: The state number is the easiest to use.

Sample 7 card game: Virginia Vermont Maine Wisconsin Oregon Colorado Utah
