

## 2-4 Players Comparing Ages 7+

**Goal:** Win the most cards when the value in the chosen category on your card is larger than your opponent's value. (Played like WAR)

- Cards are equally divided and remain in a pile in front of the players.
- Any ONE numerical category is chosen (Population, Area, Union Entry, etc.)
- Players take the top card from their pile, turn it over and compare the values of the chosen category.
- The player with the highest value wins all the cards and puts them in a separate pile.
- If 2 or more players have equal values on their cards, (a tie) ALL players in the tie play another card. Again, the highest value gets ALL the cards.
- When all cards have been played, players count the number of cards they won.
- The player with the most cards wins the game.

\*\*\*OPTIONS: Other values not obviously shown on the cards may be used.

## They are:

- Alphabetical order of the <u>State</u> or <u>Capital</u>
- The number of letters in the <u>State</u> or <u>Capital</u>
- The highest DIFFERENCE in high and low <u>Temperatures</u>
- The sum of the digits in the year of <u>Union Entry</u>
- The sum of the digits in the <u>Area</u>
- Alphabetical order of the <u>Flower</u>, <u>Bird</u>, or <u>Tree</u>
- The population density of the state (population ÷ square miles)
